(Gasoline - Expiration date stamps No. 9 in Book 13 expires each January 21, 1944.)

FUEL OIL--Period 2 coupons are good through February 13. Period 3 coupons good through March 13.

SUGAR--Stamp No. 29 in Book Four 1 good for 5 pounds through January 15, 1944. No. 30 becomes good January 16 and will be good for 5 pounds through March 31.

SHOES--Stamp No. 18 in Book One, good for 1 pair. Stamp No. 1 on the Airplane sheet in Book Three, good for 1 pair.

CANNED GOODS--Green stamps D, E and F in Book No. 4 valid through January 20. Red stamps G, H and J in Book No. 4 are good through February 20.

MEATS, FATS--Brown Stamp R, S and T are good through January 20. Brown Stamp U becomes good January 20 and remains good until March 31. Spare Stamp 2 in Book No. 4 is good for 5 pounds worth of fresh pork and all sausage through January 15.

TIRE INSCRIPTION A card auto every 6 months or by March 31 (inspections must be at least 90 days apart).

WOOD, SAWDUST, COAL Fuel does not cost more wood, sawdust and coal on priority based on consumer need, with those having less than three months' supply coming first.
