Reminders

(Argus April 13, 1944)

GASOLINE COUPONS: Not valid unless endorsed, June 21—Expiration date of No. 11 "A" coupons. May renew for 5 coupons without cost not before 15 days from date on cover.

FUEL OIL: September 25, expiration date of period 4 and 5 coupons. For 5 coupons through February 28, 1945. Apply at local OPA board for more (maximum 20 coupons per person).

PROCESSED FOODS: Block 4—Blue stamps AS through KS, valid indefinitely.

MEATS, BUTTER, FATS AND CHEESE: Block 4—Red stamps AS through MS valid indefinitely. Red stamps NS, PS, QS valid indefinitely beginning April 25.

SHOES: Jones stamps invalid—Block 1, stamp 18, valid for one pair, expires April 30. Block 3, airplane stamp No. 1, valid indefinitely for one pair. (New stamp to become valid May 1 for one pair).

THE INSPECTION: "A" every 6 months; "B" every 6 months; "C" every 3 months; "D" every 6 months or 6,000 miles of driving.

STOVES: Apply at local OPA board for purchase certificate.

RENT CONTROL: Housing units rented for first time must be registered by landlords within 30 days.

PRICE CONTROL: Refer price clerk of your local war price and rationing board.
