MEAT, BUTTER, CHEESE—Book 4—Red stamps A5 through Z8 and A5 through Z8, valid indefinitely.

SUGAR—Book 4—Sugar stamps 39, 31, 22, 23 and 24 valid indefinitely, 3 pounds each. Sugar stamp 40 valid through February 28, 1945, for 5 pounds home canning only.

SHOES, home stamps invalid—Book 3. Airplane stamps 1, 2 and 3 valid indefinitely.

GASOLINE COUPONS—Endorse new coupons before using—"A" 13 expires December 31. Each coupon worth 4 gallons.

STOVES—Apply local board for purchase certificate for oil, gas stoves. FUEL OIL—Period 4 and 5 coupons (1943-44 series) and period 1 and 2 coupons (1944-45 series) valid through August 31, 1945. Not more than 27% of season's rationals should have been used by that date.

WOOD, COAL, SAWDUST—Delivery by priorities based on written statement of needs. PRICE CONTROL—Report overcharges to price clerk at local OPA board.

RENT CONTROL—All rented dwelling units must be registered, and changes in tenancy reported to local OPA board. Hillsboro Ration Office—2nd floor, Wells building, N. E. corner 2nd and Main.
