County Financial Status Reported For Six Months

Tax collections during the last half of 1944 totaled \$939,942.17, according to the semi-annual report released this week by Sheriff J. W. Connell. Cash balances on hand at the end of the year amounted to \$419,728.39, were revealed in statements by County Clerk W. A. Tupper and County Treasurer Maud W. Boscow.

Bulk of the tax collections reported were on the 1944-45 roll and totaled \$891,922.23. Amount received on the 1943-44 taxes came to \$41,661.30.
