Service Letters

Tells of Canal Trip

Following are excerpts from letters written by Bud Rickford to his parents, telling about his trip to Balboa through the Panama Canal and thence to the east coast.

Just twenty-four hours from the time I left you in Portland to San Pedro, the plane trip was fine.

This is March 28 and tomorrow we sail. We have been moved from the Atlantic reserve fleet to the Atlantic Active Fleet. I am not too hot about that but I then went to check them off to make sure that we got all that we ordered.

April 1st—We are just on the northern fringe of the Bahamas. We went through Windward pass last night. It seems to cut through one side of Cuba. Our rough weather has passed. It is nice out, and has started to grow cooler, but then I am getting used to going from one climate to another, as that is all we have been doing since we left Japan.

There is a large ship to the west.

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
