

### Beaverion Club Sponsors Floral Show for Fair

Floral show at the Washington county fair at Hillsboro August 29, 30 and 31, will be sponsored this year by the Beaverion Garden club, according to an announcement this week by Leon S. Davis, fair manager. Other garden clubs in the county, including Hillsboro, Forest Grove and Aloha will cooperate with the Beaverion group. Sponsoring club has not announced plans for the show but it is expected that the displays will be housed in the garage building again this year. Competition will be open for flowers of all kinds, roses, dahlias, gladioli and house plants. Other divisions will include artistic flower arrangements and garden photographs.

Floral show has been one of the features of the county fair and was the only senior competition continued during the war years. Flower exhibitors are urged to start making plans now to enter the show.
