Alvord Farm Hit by Blaze

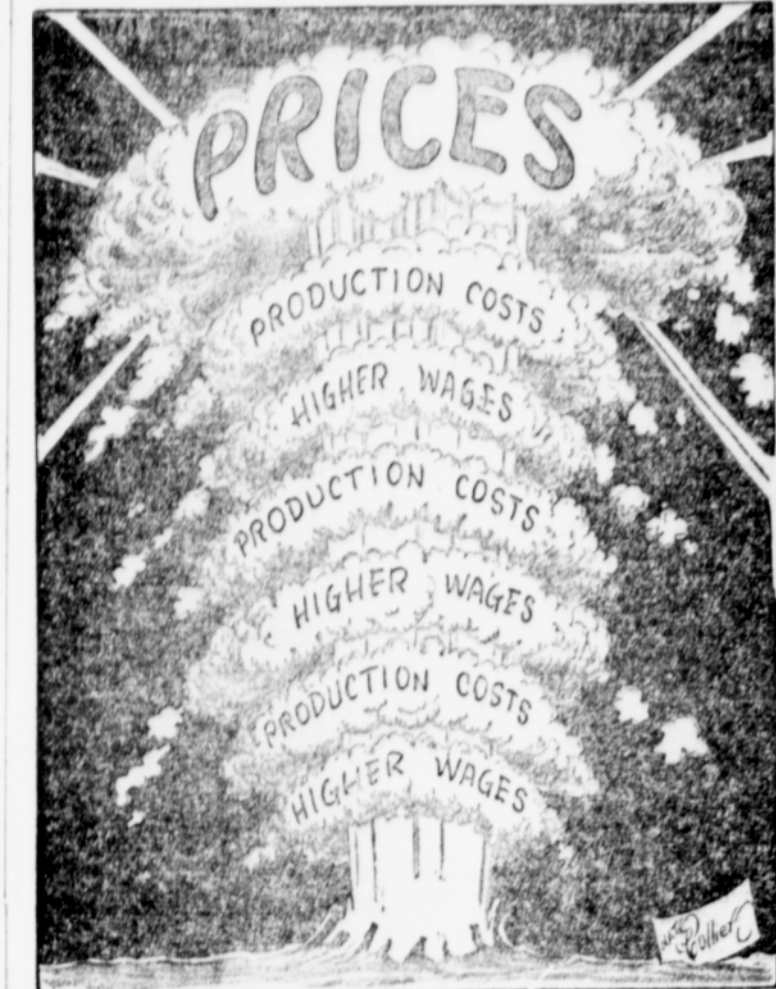
Fire early Friday morning destroyed several buildings and caused considerable damage at the Alvord farm, route 2, Hillsboro.
