

Clothing Clubs Hold Top Interest for 4-H Youths

The biggest drawing point for Washington county 4-H club members in 1947 was the clothing clubs, which enrolled 375 youngsters during the year, it was revealed Monday by Faye Nichols and Joe Cox, county extension agents.

Clothing club members constructed 338 garments and 776 articles, and renovated 63 garments during the year, the agents announced. Of the 1238 boys and girls enrolled in county 4-H clubs in the year, 87 participated in dairy clubs, the leading activity in agricultural activities.

Members in cookery clubs prepared and served 824 meals, 4269 single dishes and 992 bakings. A total of 425 quarts of fruit and 1805 quarts of vegetables were canned by boys and girls in the food preservation project. In addition, 640 containers of fruit, 236 packages of vegetables, and 496 containers of meat were frozen.

Health club members studied good habits in nutrition, clothing, safety, sanitation, and good sportsmanship.

In the livestock projects, dairy club members owned a total of 145 animals with a valuation of \$17,504. Twenty-one boys and girls fattened a total of 23 beef steers with a total value of \$243. Swine projects were carried by nine boys and girls who had a total of 34 hogs. Two club members carried a sheep project.

Increased interest was shown this year in 4-H poultry work with 15 boys and girls having 1656 birds valued at \$1948.25. The same number of club members raised rabbits.

Crops projects included 28 gardens, 15 acres of field crops and four acres of corn. These projects were valued at \$2386.

The farm safety project was carried by 20 boys and girls. One of the outstanding events of the year

was a safety speech contest held early in the year. Club members contributed to farm, home and community safety.

Forestry, woodworking and leathercraft work was carried on by 103 club members. The forestry club members planted trees on the new Washington county fairgrounds as well as their projects. Two club members did rose and flower projects individually.

In completing the year's work, achievement meetings have been held in many communities in the county. Miss Nichols and Cox added.

Squirrels cut off telephone service along seven miles of cable in Leesburg, Va., by puncturing the lead-lined cable with their teeth and causing a short circuit.

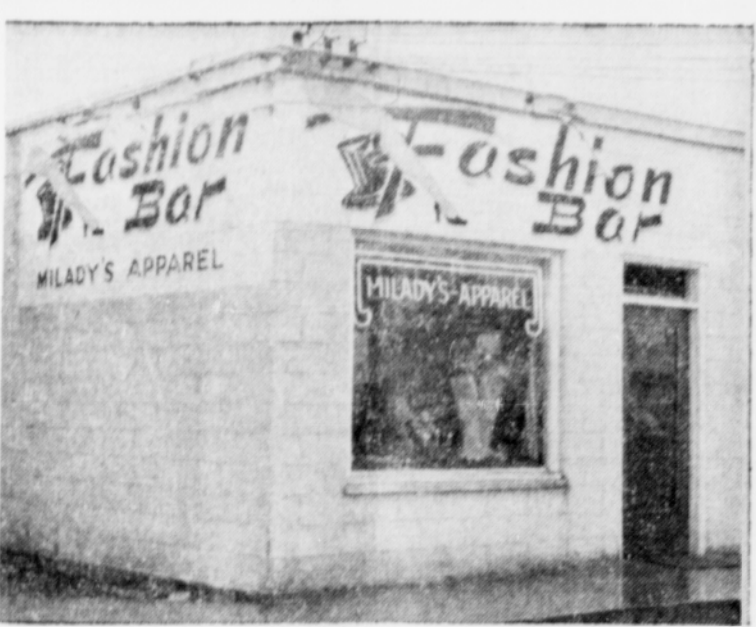

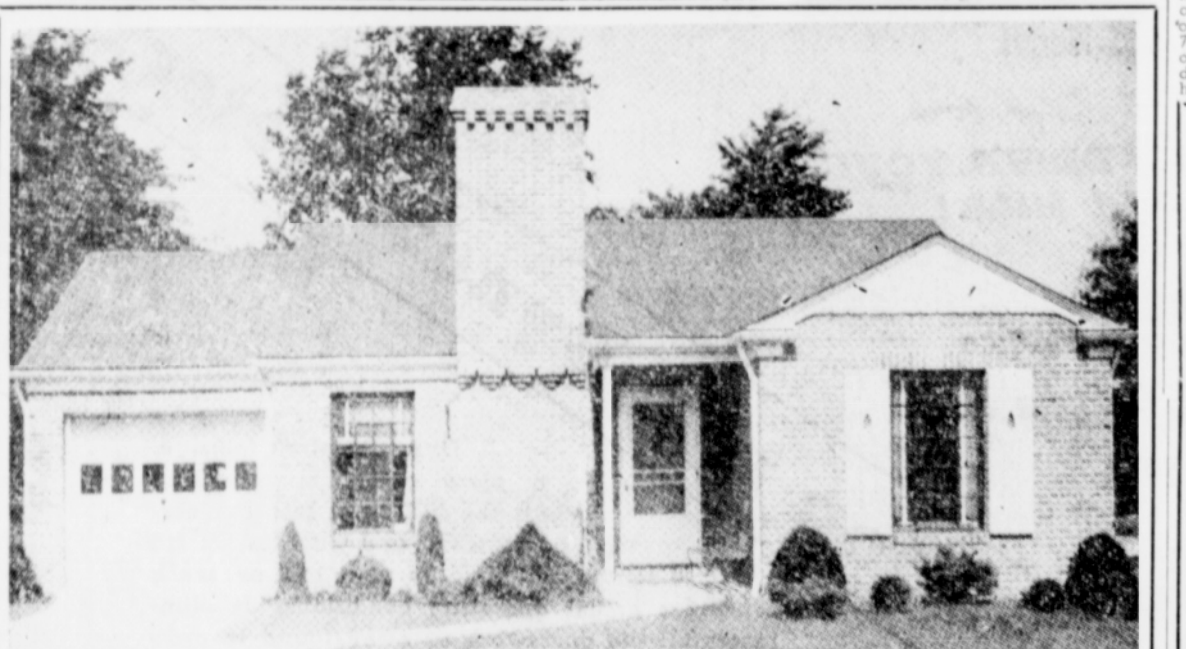
