

Red Cross Man Favors Covered Swimming Pool

Only a fraction of the full value of a swimming pool can be derived from an open-air pool, Richard J. Evans, Pacific area field representative for Red Cross first aid, water safety and accident prevention, told the Hillsboro Recreation commission at a special meeting here last week.

The cost of an open-air pool is too high to justify its construction here or any place, he added, explaining that such a pool would be idle about nine months each year. Figures based on many years of experience show that a closed pool built in connection with a grade school will cost 25 per cent less than an open-air pool constructed at Shute park or some other location, he said.

He recommended location of a

pool adjacent to a grade school rather than a high school because of the need to teach children to swim properly before they reach high school age. The Red Cross, he added, will train supervisors free of charge.

Giving examples of uses to be made of pools, Evans said one pool in Aberdeen, Wash., provides facilities which have permitted instituting a compulsory swimming program in the schools and issuance of 4000 swimming certificates a year. The pool, open from September 1 to June 1, is used by 20,000 people a year. Handled in conjunction with the schools, the pool is operated on an annual budget of \$7500, which covers maintenance and supervision.

Evans listed life saving value as the principal value to be derived from a pool. Other values, he said, are: Remedial, especially for physically handicapped, recreational and competitive.

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Grove Pilot Dies In Plane Crash

Captain Julius O. Lemcke, 25,

marine corps fighter pilot from Forest Grove, was killed last Tuesday in a mid-air crash of two planes near Elinore, Cal. The planes crashed during maneuvers, operating from the El Toro marine air base.

He was a veteran of 26 months of combat in the South Pacific and had received his wings one year ago. He participated in the campaigns of Bougainville, Guam and Iwo Jima and was awarded the bronze cross for action on Guam. He won the navy cross for the Iwo Jima campaign.

He was born April 1, 1922, in Germany and came to the United States at the age of 11 months. He was graduated from Forest Grove high school. Military services were held at El Toro air base. The body was shipped to Forest Grove for services and burial.

Surviving are his wife, Miriam; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. F. Lemcke of Forest Grove; two brothers, G. A. Lemcke, Huntville, Texas.
