### County Health Officer to Take Leave of Absence

Dr. H. M. Stolte will take a nine-month leave of absence from his post as health officer of the Yamhill-Washington county district, beginning September 1. He will go to Berkeley, Cal., to enroll in the graduate school of public health. The work will be a master's degree in public health.

No interim health officer has yet been named by the state board of health, which makes appointment to the office, subject to the approval of the public health district.

Dr. Stolte began twice-weekly visits to the Washington county health offices in July 1944, when Dr. F. T. Burke resigned to enter private practice. He has continued until the present on a part time basis, making visits to Washington county on Tuesday and Friday of each week, and the third Thursday of each month.

He became health officer for the Yamhill - Washington district in July, 1947, when the county courts authorized the merging of the health work in the two counties. He began public health work in January, 1940, as the medical officer for Yamhill county.

### County School Head Tells Fall Plans

upper grade pupils will be taken to other schools for the year with the possibility of a new consolidated building in another year.

Manning will have a new building to replace the old structure, which was destroyed by fire last spring. An additional building is being constructed in northeast Beaverton to open as last year with an addition and remodeled present building scheduled to be ready by the first of the year. Aloha will have five new classrooms, heating plant, health room, teachers' room and gymnasium ready for occupancy in September.

### High Schools Same

All high schools in the county will operate as last year. Scraford's report stated, with several additions and considerable remodeling completed during the summer.

Among the non-high school districts, Cornelius will send pupils to Hillsboro and Forest Grove; Baco, to Hillsboro; Buck Heaven, to Hillsboro; Kansas City, to Forest Grove and Scappoose; Garden Home, which operated as a non-high school district last year, is now a part of the Beaverton union high school district and pupils will attend there this year.

Suspended districts which will transport pupils to other schools are the following: Centerville — to Hillsboro, Cornelius and Verbort; Leysville — to Hillsboro; Greenville — to Banks and other schools; Roy — to other schools; Buck Heaven — to Newberg; Iowa Hill — to Hillsboro; Kansas City — to Forest Grove and other schools; Fairview — to Forest Grove; Mason Hill — to Hillsboro and Skyline; Mountain Home — to Greener and Sherwood; Strassel — to the Gales Creek district, and Carpenter Creek — to Forest Grove.

### Merged Districts

Districts which have been consolidated are Snute, now part of Hillsboro school district; Kinton, added to Greener and McKay; Mountsindale, part of new district 43; Mountsindale school will operate; Shady Brook, part of district 43 (will operate Shady Brook building for grades five and six); Arcade, part of district 43 (will operate Arcade building for six grades); Fir Creek, part of new Gales Creek district which will operate Fir Creek building; Pleasant View, part of district 43 (pupils will attend North Plains); Lyda, part of Gales Creek district which will operate the Lyda building this year; Bethany, part of new Union district; Wilson, part of Gales Creek district; Jedmore, part of new Gales Creek district, which will operate Jedmore building.
