

Venetian Theatre Slates Reopening After Changes

Upon completion of the design, carpeting and painting, the Venetian theatre will reopen in August after a four-day period of work during which time the theatre was closed.

According to Orange Phelps, owner, the theatre has been improved to include the most modern facilities in comfort and accommodations. A completely new balcony will be opened and will consist of a large section of 125 seats.

On the main floor of the theatre, new fully upholstered seats and carpets have been installed and the total seating capacity has been enlarged to accommodate over 800 patrons. Phelps pointed out that the new accommodations of the Venetian will make it one of the most modern and equipped theatres in the northwest.

Other new accommodations include a new women's lounge, new men's lounge and a "crying" room in the balcony for ladies and their mothers.

Rebuilding and redecorating of the theatre has been carried on over a period of a year and a half to avoid extended closure of the show house. The reopening tonight (Thursday) will feature a two-act fall of "Edward My Son," with Spencer Tracy and "Bad Men of Tombstone."


