PATENT GATE, ETC.

Self-Opening and Self-Closing
GATE.

PATENTED BY JOHN DICKSON,
June 4, 1867.

THE GATE IS SO CONSTRUCTED THAT
when the vehicle approaches it the
wheels on one side pass over a lever which
is connected to the gate hinge by a rod,
thus opening the gate before you and fast-
ening it open. After going through, the
carriage passes over a similar lever, also
connected with the gate hinge, causing the
gate, in its rotation, to shut behind you
and fasten.

This gate is simple in its construction,
both of iron and wood work, and not likely

end laid in the bottom bar, which is the
style of a factory made gate. The gates
