Many cities and towns in the Eastern and Middle States observed the Fourth of July with more than usual spirit. In Philadelphia, the great event was the transfer of the Centennial grounds to the Centennial Commission. A proclamation by the President was read at the grounds which cited the act of Congress providing for a national celebration, and closed as follows: "Now, therefore be it known that I. Ulysses S Grant. President of the United Sates, in contormity with the provisions of the act of Congress aforestid, do hereby declare and proclaim that there will be held at the City of Philadelphia, State of Pennsylvania, an International Exhibition of arts, manufactures, and products of soil and mines, to be opened on the 19th day of April, 1576. and to be closed on the 19th day of October of the same year; and in the interest of peace, civilization and domestic and internal friendship, and in behalf of the people 1 cordially commend the same to all nations who may be pleased to take part therein. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the United States to be affixed. Done at the City of Washington this third day of July, in the year of our Lord 1873. and of the hatependence of the United States the 97th. Signed
