retards somewhat the movement of our grain. Or perhaps it would be nearer the truth to say that want of ready money prevents cash purchases, to a considerable degree. The vessels in the river are receiving cargo as rapidly as circumstances will admit, from lots previously purchased. The only change of character we have to note, is the advance in tonnage rates from Pacific ports, within the past few days. There is apparently no reason for this as there are about as many ships on the way as can get grain charters. Corner or ring influence, no doubt, has brought about the advance. The rates from San Francisco to Liverpool are now £3 15s as against £3 5s a short

The Commercial Horald says: "A largely increased business in Salmon curing is promised in 1874 on the Columbia river, as well as upon Rogue river and other streams in Oregon. At present the market is well stocked with barrel Salmon from the North; also, salmon bellies in kits from Rouge river. There is considerable interest by large Liveapool dealers for Pacific salmon for the year 1874. The good quality of that bought and shipped last year has been productive of good results in every way, and the trade prospects are xceedingly encouraging. A very large capital will be employed this season in the prosecution of this interest in Oregon waters and some of our merchants, as agents of the packers, are prejured to do a large business in the way of making contract sales." 
