The county commissioners of Randolph county, Illinois, at their session last week, established the salary of county officers as follows: County Judge, \$1,500; County Clerk, \$2,000 salary and \$2,400 for clerk hire; Circuit Clerk, \$2,000 salary and \$3,400 for clerk hire deputies and bailiffs. School Superintendent shall be allowed all necessary time employed in visiting schools, provided he shall not be so employed over 155 days, at \$4 per day, to gether with all commissions of his office; Assessor and Treasurer, \$1,400 salary, exclusive of fees of deputies, to be paid by the county.

The *Mountaineer* says there will probably be collected in Wasco county about \$16,000 taxes for county purposes, which will leave about \$3,000 to apply on indebtedness of \$11,656—leaving the county in debt at the end of the year \$8,657. The current expenses of Wasco county for the year ending June, 1873, were \$14,904. The expenses of the county for this year are likely to be \$1,900 less than last year, which is not to be attributed to any abatement of fees and salaries, but to the fact that there has been less criminal expense to the county, and other irregular expenses, as shown by the exhibit of 1873.

An Idaho school teacher has introduced a new feature in his school. When one of the girls misses a word the boy who spells it gets permission to kiss her. The result is that the girls are fast forgetting all they ever knew about spelling, and while the boys are improving with wonderful rapidity.

Two hundred and eighty Menonite families arrived at Yankton, Dakota in, April. They had already sent instructions to their friends there to procure stock and lands for them, and have gone to work to make that wilderness blossom.

A young man named Howard was arrested on a charge of seduction by the Sheriff of Lane county at Junction a few days ago. He is brother to a man under arrest at the same place of a charge of bigamy.

Dick, the fisherman, on Thursday morning last landed upon the Vancouver wharf a monster sturgeon measuring ten feet and four inches in length, five feet and nine inches in circumference, and weighing nearly 700 pounds. We believe it to be the largest fish ever captured in the Columbia.
