A report is current in London that a crisis has occurred in the affairs of the Prince of Wales, and the Ministry propose that the House of Commons shall pay his debts.

The amount is 40,000 pounds sterling - four times the amount voted in 1867 to appease the creditors of this pattern of royalty.

One view is that the honor of the nation is concerned in providing for these debts. Another is that these debts are of a character which ought to be paid out of the accumulated fortune of the Queen.

The latter view is based on the well known fact that she has been receiving ever since the death of Albert the whole income calculated at her accession to support the expense of a Court in the usual degree of splendor.

Her Majesty has, however, lived during this period for the most part in retirement, and that the cost of drawing room, layees and other royal pageantry has, in fact, fallen upon the Prince and Princess of Wales, whose income has been unequal to such a burden.

Two parties of railway surveyors will immediately operate on the Fraser river route. One party under Mr. Cambie, will survey the route down as far as Simpson's rapids.

To Victoria the Enterprise brought down five hundred cases of canned salmon from Deas's fishery, near the mouth of the Fraser. Enormous quantities of salmon are being put up at that establishment, as also at similar establishments further up the river.

The steamer Henry Amos, from St. Louis to New Orleans, with a cargo of 1,800 tons assorted merchandise, struck a snag near Water Proof on the night of the 7th inst., and sunk in twenty-five feet of water. Four lives lost. Boat and cargo valued at \$130,000.
