Alfalfa Hay for Milch Cows.

We are we'l satisfied that for milch cows altalfa hay is more valuable than any other. It will ... ake more milk, and of a better quality, than any other kind of hay. In fact, we believe-and our belief is founded upon actual experience in feeding-that cows will give more milk and make more butter or cheese when kept in the stable and fed on good alfalfa hav alone, than they will when running in the pasture and feeding on a plenty of good native grass. We have fed cows on oat hay and given them a good slop twice a day, and we are sure that with this feed they will not thrive as well or give as much milk as when fed on alfalfa hay and no bran at all. The alfalfa, however, to secure these good qualities, must be cut before in blossom, and must be cared without exposure to the sun, so that all the nutriment will be retained in the stem and all the leaves be retained. It not cut until too ripe, and then dried in the sun, it becomes of but little more value as hay for any use than so much willow brush.

The cheap rate of living in Europe, as compared with our fashiorable watering place scale of prices, is having its effect to send an unusually large number of summer tourists across the water. Added to this incentive is the low rate charged by the steamboat lines, the effect of competition. Steerage passage is exceedingly cheap, and it is said that it will fall to \$10 betore the end of the season. Saloon passage is extremely low, some lines carrying passengers for \$50.
