



An officer in the English navy has Att'ys for Adm's, constructed a table for estimating, with all needful accurancy, the amount of wheat on an acre of land, St. John's Lodge, No. 62, in Foster before it is harvested. The estimates lock, 2nd Saturday of each month. can be made as soon as the grain ripe. Make a wood or iron frame one yard square, carefully let it down over the standing grain, and shell and weigh all the grain on the straws belonging inside the frame. From


