

THE WASTE OF DRINK.

Investigations made by the Cinthis liquor the "Price Current" esti- ate reached the outer line of rifle pits, mates that the people paid about they found the regulars. \$10,000,000, or \$27,400 per day, or \$25 per aunum for each individual of the population, including children. In addition to this tax upon industry is the amount expended for spirituous liquors, cigars, tobacco, etc.

Ten millions of dollars! What would this sum do? It would pur chase a thousand farms of a hundred acres each, at a hundred dollars per acre, which would be equivalent to a territory twelve and a half miles square, lying in the best farming regions of Ohio or Kentucky, and including all buildings, orchards, roads and other improvements.

It would purchase ten thousand building loss in the suburbs of the great city where it was swallowed, and build on each of the-e a neat cottage of four or five rooms, and thus make a comfortable home for each of ten thousand laboring men's families, or fifty thousands persons.

It would buy one hundred milition pounds of meat, at ten cents per pound -enough to furnish an army of a hundred thousand men with the standard army ration for a year.

It would buy nearly two million barrels of the best grade of flourenough to furnish a year's supply of bread for four hundred thousand people-more than the entire population of the cities named.

Is it any wonder that Cincinnati is in constant terror of riot and murder, fire and pillage, when such a flood of devil's broth as this money represents is annually poured down the threats of her citizens ?

Let it be remembered that these statistics are for mait liquors alone, and do not include wines or alcoholic liquers, of which an enormous additional amount is consumed. Let it be remembered, also, that the statistics are not those of "temperance fanatics," but a body of business men,






