The enormous proportions to which life in insurance has grown receive a striking illustration in the figures given by Bradstreet's, from the report of the New York state superintendent of insurance for the last year. These figures show increases in the surplus of the life insurance companies and in the amount of insurance in force. The assets of the 29 life insurance companies amounted to \$641,747,870 in 1888, as against \$595,659,478. Their liabilities amounted to \$956,399,843 in 1888, as against \$825,251,812 in the preceding year. The surplus amounted to \$97,357,028 in 1888, as against \$72,427,666 in the preceding year; and the insurance in force amounted to \$4,861,577,128, as against \$2,474,597,120.

The king of Siam is supposed to own the people, and each man in the realm has to serve for three, six or nine months as a servant of the government. At a certain time of the year the entire population is marked off to particular soldiers or government masters. These masters are required to furnish workmen for the government and the men under them must obey. All kinds of work are demanded. Some men are required to give all their time to the government, and in this case they get nominal salaries. Those who give half their time work for the king 15 days and then have 15 days off. The three months subjects get no pay, and during the time they are Bangkok they have to find themselves food and lodging. This work practically enslaves the whole population of males and slavery is common in Siam.

TELEGRAPHIC NEWS

TACOMA, May 7.—The city election came off to day, and the democrats have elected. A Wheelwright mayor by about 150 majority. The courts in the Second and Third wards are progressing very slowly, but so far indicate the election of Charles T. Uhlman, rep., for councilman over Lewis F. Hoagland, street commissioner.

SAN FRANCISCO, May 7.—Trouble from landslides is feared by the Southern Pacific company along the Shasta division, where rain was falling heavily to day. Some small slides occurred, and the loosening of the ground has been general in the cuts that much damage is threatened. Snow has fallen to depth of two feet on the Sierrita range. The Southern Pacific reported to day that four and a half inches of snow had fallen at the summit of the Central Pacific railroad, and that it was still coming.

A Big Storm. ST. PAUL, May 7.—It had been blowing hard all day yesterday and last night in the Northwest. The wind to-day increased to a gale and considerable damage was done. Reports are coming in from the country of damage to buildings and crops. At Buffalo, in this county, the storm reached its greatest severity, what in many places being blown out of the ground by the wind. In other places it is buried so deep that it will never come up.

Take Possession. NEW ORLEANS, May 7.—The Times Democrat's Lafayette special says: Four hundred armed men, under General Alexander Delecluse of St. Martin's parish, rode into Lafayette this morning, took possession of the town and demanded the resignation of a negro justice of the peace and negro constables. The latter had disappeared, but the former complied with their demand.

On to B.C. SEATTLE, W. T., May 6.—The representatives of the Eastern syndicates, who have been examining the Bellingham Bay railroad, have reported favorably on the road and its management. This insures the loan of \$125,000, which will complete the road from Seattle to New Westminster, a distance of 148 miles.

Germany will not claim political preponderance.
