Two drummers had a live water fight with hose at Lebanon yesterday. They came to Albany soaked.

The Salem cannery has been sold to W. K. Allen for \$10,000. It is said to have cost \$50,000, paid out by Banker Wallace.

In a few months the form of money orders is to be changed so that there will be a receipt with each order as an evidence, the same as with Wells Fargo. A good idea.

Prof. F. G. Young, of the State University, formerly of Albany, has just bought the McClure residence in Eugene paying \$3,000 for the same.

S. N. Steele yesterday sold for B. A. Stafford the residence now occupied by Prof. Martindale to Mrs. Poindexter, mother of Mrs. W. H. Parker, for \$800.

The poundmaster and a drayman met yesterday evening pugilistically over a calf the drayman claimed was not getting well enough for its health. It was a live mill according to reports.

Arrangements for the reception of the volunteers at this city will be postponed until Maj Ellis and Capt. Phillips are heard from, their wishes being consulted first in reference to the program.

The Grangers left Albany at 8:23 a. m. this forenoon to play the juvenile club of independence this afternoon, with a grim determination to win, after having been defeated a week ago.

The DEMOCRAT is informed that there is nothing in the report that there are to be two overlords and the time of arrival at Albany materially changed.

The Statesman says that A. Klein has recently completed the construction of a modern dwelling on Oak street in University addition. It is a very beautiful structure and cost approximately \$2,000.

J. A. Cain, a Brownsville butcher, has begun proceedings in bankruptcy. He owes about \$600 to Brownsville people and his assets are a piece of property valued at \$300 fully mortgaged and personal property exempt.

Not a man from Albany had to go to the hospital at Presidio, and it is an interesting fact that not a single man from this city was injured except Maj. Ellis, whose wound was only slight.

The fine residence of Dr. T. K. Chapman at Monroe was burned last Thursday. Loss \$2,000, insurance \$700. Mrs. Chapman was at home alone the Dr. and his daughter being in Seio.

Eugene people believe there was no mistake made in the election of Dr. Strong to the presidency of the State University. The recommendations and praise of his character are strong ones. As a state institution it is to be hoped this proves true. The credit of the entire state demands that an up-to-date high minded man be at the head of the university and we believe such a man has been secured.

A clever swindle was recently worked on John Leedy at Minto. An old man giving the name of John Bailey claiming to be a mine operator made arrangements with John Leedy and two sons to go to Cooks inlet and work for him at \$15 a day, advancing \$300 in a check on Gilbert Bros. of Salem, and then on the strength of it borrowing a horse, saddle and bridle, a watch and \$3 all Mr. Leedy had to spare, \$35 being requested and ostensibly starting for Gold Creek but probably towards Portland. Mr. Leedy came to Albany and found the check to be worthless.
