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SATURDAY NIGHT THOUGHTS. This week has seen the advantage in the Transvaal war decidedly in favor of the Boers. With eighty thousand men in the country, England has been unable so far to cope with the sturdy inhabitants of the country who are fighting for their very plain freedoms, but dear to them just the same. The war has developed into one of the most desperate since the civil war. It is a race to face contest. Bullet for bullet. The Boer is fearless in the face of a shower of lead. It is only when he comes in contact with the sabers of the English that he weakens and falls back. The people of the United States are watching the contest with different emotions. A man in Polk county has been sentenced this week for the third time to be hanged by the neck for murder, on circumstantial evidence. And it will be done no doubt with a protestation of innocence on his lips. It is well established that circumstantial evidence is sufficient to hang a man. It may look tough, but if it were not sufficient many more men would go free than do now, for in most cases murder is committed in the dark without any witness around, hence justice would lag but for the sufficiency of this kind of evidence.
