Multnomah Democrats.

PORTLAND, March 31.—Democratic convention today including silver republicans, free democrats and populist element. T. Milno was elected temporary chairman defeating Judge Sweek. Vote, Milno 73, Sweek 56. Convention will probably adjourn for two weeks, after election state delegates. All members convention except three claim their supported Bryan in '90.

Near Bloemfontein.

LONDON, March 31.—The head of the army of Lord Roberts is now about 21 miles north of Bloemfontein. It occupies a cluster of hills won from the Boers after a stiff fight, in which the British lost seven officers and 100 men. The Boers have been using these kopjes as a base for marauding bands that have been beating up the country adjacent to Bloemfontein for supplies.

Quite Lively.

WASHINGTON, March 30.—The republican senators were gripped and pleased today. Grievous at Proctor's speech, which they say they think is the worst possible utterance that could be made for democratic campaign material, in view of the determination to pass the Puerto Rican tariff bill; pleased at the manner in which Pettus, of Alabama, poked fun at Beveridge.

The Main Thing.

ST. PAUL, March 30.—Speaker Hendrickson has written a letter to a Minnesota friend scoring the opponents of the Puerto Rican tariff bill. The speaker alludes to the "10,000,000 savages in the Philippines," and makes plainly the assertion that the main thing the tariff men are fighting for is to establish the power of Congress to rule the so-called colonies outside of the Constitution.

Fast Traveling.

SEAGWAY, March 25.—Mrs. Mahoney, wife of one of the managers of the North American Trading & Transportation Company arrived here last night. She came from Dawson to Bennett in four days and 20 hours, thereby breaking all records for fast winter travel. The trip was made with dog teams a part of the way and with horse teams the remainder.

A Proclamation.

LONDON, March 31.—The Bloemfontein correspondents of the Daily Chronicle, telegraphing March 29, says: President Kruger's latest proclamation warns the women and children to leave Bloemfontein within five days, as he intends to bombard and destroy the city and to shoot the burghers whom he captures there.

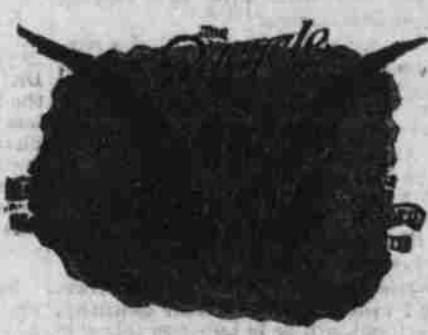
