THE ELECTION LAW.

The following is the full text of the law passed at the last session of the legislature relative to the disposal of liquors on the day of any State or city election:

Be it enacted by the Legislature Assembly of the State of Oregon: Sec. 1. That it shall be unlawful in this State for any person to barter, sell, give away or in any manner dispose of any intoxicating liquor on the day of any general or special election of State, county, or municipal officers within the State, district, county or corporation in which such election is held.

Sec. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this act shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than two hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the county jail of not less than ten nor more than thirty days, in the discretion of the court.

Sec. 3. That it is hereby made the duty of all magistrates, sheriffs and constables to report to the grand jury all violations of the provisions of this act, which may come to their knowledge in their respective counties; and all fines collected under this act shall be paid into and become a part of the common school fund of the county in which the same shall be collected.

A few days since the Provincial of the order of Jesuits domiciled in Vienna received a pocket containing a sealed letter addressed to the General of the order, in which an energetic young man offered to murder Prince Bismarck if the Jesuits would pay him through the Provincial in Vienna 200,000 florins for necessary preparations, and 1,000,000 florins in case of success.

Vice President Wilson, Speaker Blaine, and Annie Louise Cary, together with other passengers on board the New York and Boston express, recently narrowly escaped destruction. The train ran off the track. Speaker Blaine was confined to his room for a few days in consequence of bruises.

Dr. E. J. Kirksey, of Columbus, Ga., late Surgeon of the Confederate army, has accepted a position on the medical staff of the Egyptian Kaeidive, and will leave this country in July.

The London Syndicate will next month make another call on the Treasury Department for an additional number of new United States bonds, the money market being favorable to such investment.
