WASHINGTON LETTER

WASHINGTON, JULY 17, '93.
Indications increase as the time for the meeting of the extra session draws nearer that there will be just as bitter a fight among the democrats over the tariff as there will be over silver, and whether correctly or not Mr. Cleveland is now classed among those democrats who will favor a revision of the tariff on protection lines. The attempt on the part of the administration to center public attention on the silver question was the deliberate and intentional result of the conviction that it would be suicidal both for the democratic party and for the country for the democratic congress to keep the pledges made by the Chicago platform, in the construction of a tariff bill, and that it was necessary to withdraw public attention from the tariff in order to prevent the change of attitude being so noticeable. The free trade wing of the democratic party in congress, mostly from the south and west, are just beginning to catch the drift of this movement and they say they will demand that congress carry out the party platform and wipe out so much of the tariff as represents protection to home industries, and open our markets to the manufactures of the world.

It seems more probable now than at any other time since the election that the republicans in congress may be acting with that wing of the democratic party which will vote for moderate protection be able to prevent the utter destruction of many American industries that cannot possibly exist without some protection. But even with the hardest work on the part of the republicans it is probable that the reductions made in the present duties will be large enough to cause a general reduction in wages throughout the United States in order to allow our goods to compete with the products of European labor, but a reduction of wages, bad as it is, is preferable to the entire loss of employment that would necessarily follow a triumph of the free trade wing of the democratic party.

The alleged news of the preparation by England to resist by force the decision of the Behring sea arbitration should it be in favor of the United States, as it must be if the arbitrators decide without prejudice, found a few people here who took it seriously, but most people regard it as merely one of the stories of the silly season, through which the world usually passes at this season of the year. Such action on the part of England would mean war, and England does not want war with us; it would precipitate the inevitable loss of her possessions on this continent.

Secretary Morton is one of the most persistent seekers after free advertising in the present cabinet. Scarcely a day passes that he does not announce some alleged reform in some branch of the agricultural department, but as far as can be seen the only reform is in the announcement.

In order to give the democratic chiefs of divisions in the interior department full swing to promote democrats without regard to their merits the board of promotion created by Secretary Noble for the purpose of deciding what employees are entitled to promotion has been abolished and all promotions are to be made on the recommendations of the chiefs, a system which has in the past made the chiefs petty tyrants and in more than one instance blackmailers of the clerks under them.

COMPLAINTS OF THE FARMERS.

Secretary Morton has some decided views about the agricultural situation, and they do not agree in any respect with those which the populists are continually proclaiming for political purposes. It is true, he says, that the general profits of agriculture in this country have materially declined during the last ten years, not by reason, however, of unfriendly legislation, but mainly because of friendly legislation, strange as it seems. The opening of new tracts of territory to settlement and cultivation have so increased the supply of farm products, he explains, that it has run far ahead of the demands, and the natural result has been a lowering of prices. When the fact is considered that the plowed area has trebled since the homestead law was passed, and that in the same time farming implements have been so improved that one man can now do as much work as was formerly done by six men, it is easy to understand why agricultural values have decreased. The statistical records show that the market has not increased in a corresponding degree with the production, and the surplus has accordingly reduced the profits. In short, the present condition demonstrates in a very plain and conclusive way the truth of the economic maxim that the relation of supply to demand is the sole regulator of value; and this includes that other important fact that the law which thus adjusts prices cannot be reversed or evaded by artificial appliances of any sort.

The situation is unsatisfactory in this respect, but it is by no means so bad, Mr. Morton insists, as the calamitarians represent. He reminds these professional croakers that only about three per cent, of all the merchants escape failure, whereas hardly three per cent. of the farmers fail. The statistics really show that agriculture is sater than banking, manufacturing or railroading, taking all things into account. There is no farmer of good sense and good health anywhere in the West, Mr. Morton declares, who cannot make a good living for himself and family, and that is as well as the majority of men are doing in any other pursuit. The man who owns a farm and sticks to it is certain to profit by it in the future. There is practically no more land to be added to the area of cultivation. The supply of agricultural products has almost reached its limit in the United States, and must now remain stationary, while the demand will go on increasing every year. This implies a gradual improvement in prices and a steady appreciation of the value of farming lands.

The outlook is not really so discouraging, it will be seen, as the pessimists try to make it appear. There is a better time coming unquestionably. It cannot be has-
