
In the Indianapolis Sentinel of Wed-nesday was pat lished a letter purport-ing to be from Gen. Kilpatrick to Gov. Hayes, informing the latter that In-diana would be lost to the Republi-caus in October, unless the Indepen-dent party could be managed. "There is but one way to overcome this move-ment," he writes; "the leaders of the Independents are near needy and in Independents are poor, needy, and in debt. They must be lectured to, and documents must be placed in their hands to convince them of their folly." And then he calls for funds, saying that with a bloody shirt campaign and money Indiana would be safe. Our astute cotemporary the Herald, de-nounces the publication of this letter as a forgery, and an invention as stupid as it is dishonest; but our honest and candid cotemporary the Times publishes a special dispatch from the headquarters of Gov. Hayes in Ohio which says that the authenticity of the letter will not be denied, and charges that it was stolen from the little General's bedroom. In the meantime we hear from Saratoga that Gov. Hayes, acting upon Kilpatrick's advice, wrote immediately to the Republican leaders in this State for a supply of docu-ments for circulation in Indiana and that at the suggestion of the aged but wily Thurlow Weed, Gov. Morgan at once sent ten thousand of them to be put where they would do the most good. It is needless to remark that the kind of documents most likely to convince needy and seedy politicians are published in Washington and illustrated with engravings on steel .-Sun.

Schurz Shelved.

Mr. Schurz had just arranged a joint dis-cussion with Mr. Voorhees in Indiann, but failed to keep his first appoint-ment at Crown Point on the joint canvass, and it is not expected here that he will make any more speeches. He seems to be a little late in finding out that Hayes and reform and Grantism are synonymous. The Administration organ to-morrow will have an article indicating the disapproval which Republicans feel at the course of the ex-Senator in referring to the private letter which Schurz has written here predicting the defeat of the Republicans in Ohio in October, al-luded to in to-day's World.
