### A Conning Subsidy Scheme.

From the S. F. Chronicle. Sevesal years ago Congress chartered a company to build a railway from Portland, by wwy of McMinn-ville, in the Willamette Valley, to Astoria. That part of the route hetween Astoria and McMinnvile is very difficult, and the company has done noth ng on it and has forteited the land grant. Now comes Senator Mitchell, always watchful of the interests of his State, with a helping bill to revive the scheme and insure the completion of the road. His proposition is, not exactly to assist the company by a land grant outright, but to pledge the Government to the extent of the proceeds of the sales of the land grant. Now comes Senator extent of the proceeds of the sales of country. all the odd sections for the interest on the company's construction bonds. It is provided (1) that all the even sections shall be open to pre-emption and homestead settlers at \$1 25 per acre, in tracts not to exceed 160 acres for each settler. (2) That the Gov-ernment shall hold and sell the odd sections to pre emption settlers at \$2 50 per acre; and after any fifty mile section of the road shall have been completed for five years "the company shall have the right to deing even sections of land (the minimum price to be \$1 25 per acre) to the highest bidder." (3) The proceeds of all such sales of even sections, whether at \$2 50 per acre to pre-emptors, or by public sale to the highest bidder, to constitute a sinking fund, whereof the Government shall be the trustee, to liquidate the interest on the company's bonds. (4) The United States shall not be bound to pay any greater amount than shall be realized by said sinking fund. There is no doubt that if this bill
