

Why Shinn Retired.

The impression has gone abroad, says the Standard, through the kindness of a defeated candidate from Eastern Oregon, before the Democratic State Convention, that Hon. A. H. Brown bought Mr. J. Shinn, of Union county, to withdraw from the contest for Secretary of State, as coming from Eastern Oregon might impair his (Brown's) chances of receiving the nomination for State Treasurer. Mr. Brown informs us, most emphatically, that he never offered, never promised to offer, nor never would have dared to insult Mr. Shinn with any offer of money, or anything else, to refuse to allow his name to come before the convention as a candidate for Secretary of State. On the contrary, Mr. Brown says, that J. M. Shepherd, the proprietor of a paper—which he threatened to use against the Democracy unless paid handsomely—was the person who claimed the credit of getting Mr. Shinn to retire from the contest. Be this as it may, Mr. Shinn, is not a man of the Shepherd stripe, to be bought and sold like a beef, and his retirement from a contest for nomination in the Democratic Convention, was not through a purchase, but because, like an honest man, he thought by so doing he would be serving the best interests of his party.

The Multnomah Democrats and anti-Mitchell Republicans have joined their political fortunes and nominated a strong "citizens ticket" headed by J. B. Congie for State Senator. Mr. Congie is an old Oregonian, an honorable, upright citizen, and is very popular among his acquaintances. The Representative ticket is about equally divided between Democrats and Republicans, while the Democrats have the Sheriff and the Republicans the Clerk.

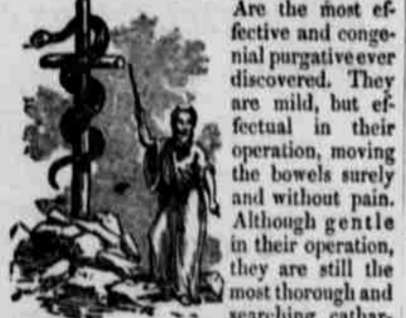
