

The Railroad Power in Congress.

From the S. F. Examiner.

A Washington correspondent says that "while Colonel Tom Scott contributes about equally to the campaign funds of both parties, Jay Gould gives only to the Republicans. Scott has schemes in which one party is just as valuable to him as the other, Gould seeks to work out all his plans within the Republican ranks. Of course, he will accept Democratic aid; as he did of Voorhees, in the matter of the Thurman Bill. The success of Thurman's measure was a galling defeat to Jay Gould, and a triumph, indirectly, for Tom Scott and the Texas Pacific. Scott does not expect to get his measure through the present Congress, but his money will go out this Summer into all the close Congressional Districts, and the candidate known in advance to be friendly to the Texas-Pacific will have money for campaign expenses, be he Democrat or Republican. Scott cares nothing for parties, but everything for the Texas-Pacific. It will be difficult for either party to count on results in close Districts where this railroad interest is so strong and so avowed in its purposes. It must be reckoned as a factor in the composition of the next House of Representatives."

The correspondent appears to neglect or ignore mention of the Central Pacific agents at Washington, with Huntington at the head. It is more to be dreaded than is Tom Scott or the Jay Gould combination. It applies its gigantic energies solely to its own purposes, in the Southern Pacific schemes and on this Coast. It will corrupt or buy legislation wherever and however it can. In this State it directs its great power to control legislation, to elect Congressmen, to the choosing of United States Senators, and, now, to predominance in the Constitutional Convention. It seeks not only to govern this State in these respects, but it aims to likewise control the other Pacific States and Territories. It overshadows every other interest and endeavor to strike down all who offer or refuse to bow to its projects and its commands. The many millions it withholds from the Federal Government, by fraud, are used as a corruption fund in Congress, in this State, and throughout this Coast. It buys Democrats and Radicals alike, and even the Workingmen's organization is corrupted and manipulated by its chief, as the mass of the honest members of that now partisan body will yet discover. Kearney is its tool, and Stanford is his master, before whom the blatant mountebank prostrates himself. And it is this colossal monopoly, and the Jay Goulds and the other unscrupulous monopolists, we repeat, that are to be more feared, in their designs and assaults upon the public treasury and the public welfare, than any others who are in league against the rights of the people.
