France has been offered thirty times the amount of money she saked for at three percent-interest. The Republilicans force the United States to go on paying six per cent for money that they can borrow at three. The United States recently sold their four-per-cents at par. The bank syndicate is peddling them out to the general public at fourteen per cent premium and pocketing the difference. That is one of the reasons why they do not like a three percent bond. It would not permit of their making millions in premiuma.

In spite of all the accessible evidence to the contrary, some persons persist in believing, or at any rate in amerting. that immigration is responsible for most of the crime that keeps our courts and our prisons full. Chicago has a very large fereign born population. The Chicago Superintendent of Police reports that 28,480 arrests were made in that cicy last year. Of the persons arrested, 3,369 were born in Germany 5,014 were born in Ireland, 4,612 were born in other foreign countries, and 15,485 were born on the soil of the United States.

Nearly thirty thousand immigrants arrived at Castle Garden during the stormy month of March. This un precedented number gives a forecast of what may be expected in the mild months of May, June and July. Last year's immigration surpassed any on record, and yet the March serivals were only a little over twenty one theusand. We may look for a round half million Vefore the year ends




