

Murder Will Out.

About two years ago a murder occurred in the northerly end of Clackamas county in which Mrs. Hagar, a respectable woman, had her head split open with an axe. The deed was done under peculiar circumstances and it was regarded as a cold blooded atrocity. Great excitement was produced all over Clackamas county, and, in fact, the entire State, when the details of the bloody act were made known. The murder was committed for the sake of robbery, and among other things taken by the wretches, was a valuable gold watch-chain. Three men were arrested and tried on suspicion of being implicated in the murder. They were named respectively Bernard, Fairchild and King. The two former were acquitted, but King was sent to State prison for life. There was a large majority of people who thought him innocent at the time, and still think so. Within a few days back some new facts have come to light in regard to the tragedy. A gold watch chain has been identified as the one owned by Mrs. Hagar is now in the possession of a young man at Oregon City to whom it was sold by Andy Sprowls. The latter was engaged as a wood chopper on John Meldrum's farm, and at the time was strongly suspected of having a hand in the murder. He has left for parts unknown.
