

The Counterfeit Bonds.

The present excitement in Washington over the counterfeiting business, which seems to be carried on right under the eyes of the Treasury officials, leads the Brooklyn Eagle to pertinent observations:

"During the last Presidential campaign and prior thereto it was distinctly charged that fraudulent Government bonds and currency had been freely used by the local agents of the Republican National Committee for the purpose of influencing the result of the Western elections. That these forgeries were perpetrated through the connivance or with the knowledge of certain Treasury Department officials was inferred from the fact that the genuine plates were used in the printing. Twenty-five millions of dollars are reported to be represented in the bogus issues; and now, several years after the charges were made public, the matter for the first time is being investigated by a Secretary of the Treasury who was not in office when the frauds were perpetrated."

What revelations of crime and corruption may be expected when the American people make up their minds to turn out the party now in power and substitute an Administration that has no motive to conceal these iniquities!

A good thing has been done by the Texas Legislature, to protect the public morals. A bill has been passed taxing all persons selling the Police Gazette Police News and similar illustrated journals \$500 per annum in each county where such papers are sold. This tax operates as a prohibition, and practically prevents the sale or publication of papers that are doing much to undermine the morals of the young of both sexes. The example of Texas may well be followed elsewhere.
