
Stenewall Jackson at Cedar Mountain.

An eyewitness of the battle of Cedar mountain describes the appearance of the Confederate General Jackson on the day of the battle, August 9, 1862: "When the dead were being buried I saw for the first time General Stonewall Jackson. He was standing in an open field quietly observing the ambulance corpse performing their sad duties, with that gay cavalier Gen. Jeh Stuart by his side. He was dressed in a faded grey suit, looking quite austere, as Stuart, with his accustomed hilarity, chatted merrily of the events which had recently transpired. I approached to within a few feet of where they stood, to get a good look at the general whose fame had already become world-wide. And during the half hour I was near him I never heard him speak or saw him smile. Stuart did all the talking, while Jackson's eagle eye was scanning the movements on the field in our front."

On last Saturday Capt. Stafford, an old citizen of Union county, who lives on his farm two miles west of Union, while climbing over a fence struck the breech of his shotgun suddenly against the ground, at the same time having his right hand over the muzzle. The concussion caused the gun to discharge; the entire contents of one barrel passing through the hand, making a fearful wound. He is nearly 70 years of age, and may have to suffer amputation of his hand in order to save his


