The Value of Silver.

The price of silver is now much lower than formerly. It has probably depreciated to the extent of one-sixth its price a quarter of a century ago. Commercial statistics show that Chis cheapening of the price, not only of silver but also of gold, has been going on almost steadily for several centuries, owing, as a general thing, to the increase of production. Latterly the money kines of the world special spe use, with the selfish thing object of reducing the quantity of lawful coin, and thus making it easier to control the operations of the money market. Silver mining is now a very considerable business. There is a population amounting to a quarter of a million persons in the United States directly or indirectly dependent upon this business for its support. The profits upon the mines are very great in some cases, and the enterprise of opening a mine is a very attractive one. Perhaps the net profits of all the silver mining done in our country might amount to fifteen millions of dollars per annum, on a gross annual product of sixty millions. Of late years the amount of silver used in the arts and in manufactures has been very great, and has constituted a good portion of the supply, so that the fall in the price of the article can be traced very clearly to its rejection from the currency of some of the nations, causing large amounts of it to enter the market as a mere commodity.

NEW LAW AS TO JUDORS. - As a mutter of interest to all citizens subject to jury duty, the new law as to jurors is given. It was passed at the last session of the Legislature, and was designed to break up the system of "professional jurymen," a class of men who hang around the courts for the express purpose of serving on juries. The amended law reads: No person is competent to act us a juror who has been convicted of any felony, or a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude. 




