Gilding the New Nickels.

There is some nlarm felt at the possibility that the new nickel may be gilded and passed off on the unsuspecting as a half-eagle. The new coin has just appeared in this community, and, while it is gradually becoming familiar, the public will do well to be upon their guard. The fact that it has already been taken by some unwary persons in Eastern cities in place of the coin it slightly resembles, and that arrests have been made of those passing it shows that there is some danger, though mistakes may be easily avoided. No one need be deceived who makes even a cursory examination, for the imitation is much more obvious than in some of the counterfeit half-eagles which have appeared in this commun nity. The new nickel is a trifle smaller than the half-eagle and much lighter. The difference in weight should be perceptible even to the careless touch. Further differences are strong'y a arked. The head is considerably larger and differently posel, though there is a general resemblance. Should a person fail to notice the difference in weight or the slight variation in the head, the merest glance at the reverse side is enough to prevent deception. The nickel has a large figure "5," surroundel by a wreath and the words "United States of America," while the reverse side of the half-eagle bears the national bird and the same legend. Only the habitually heedless need be beguiled into taking the pretty new coin for more than its value.

A Sorely Afflicted Family.

A few months ago a family by the name of Clark came to Waitsburg, says the Times, consisting of a man, his wife and ten children. Since their arrival here the eleventh child has been torn into the family. The father was affected with an incurable malady which had been preying upon his constitution for the last three years, and a son of 17 years was also an invalid. They were poor and needy, and the entire working force of the family consisted of one boy about twelve years old and two sisters older than he. These have been constantly employed in providing for the wants of the family and waiting upon the sick. 


