SECOND DEGREE.

Harry Adams Convicted of Murder
in the Second Degree for the
Killing of Dr. Brownlee.

The trial of the State vs. Harry Adams ended last night and has been one of the hardest fought trials ever tried in Lane County. This morning at 7 o'clock, a. m., the jury brought in a verdict of murder in the second degree, the penalty for which is imprisonment for life in the penitentiary. Sentence will be passed upon him at 1:30 this afternoon. When the jury brought in the verdict the prisoner did not seem affected to any great degree.

FIRE!

The Harness Shop of Wm. Preston
Nearly Destroyed by Fire.

The fire bell at 1:30 A. M. this morning sent out its thrill notes, telling our people of another fire. The Engine Co. and Ladder Co. arrived at the scene of the conflagration in a remarkably short time, and found it to be the harness shop of Mr. Wm. Preston. The engine was fully manned, and, we think, a machine never did better work, and in less than 20 minutes the fire was extinguished.

Mr. Preston's loss will be about as follows: Damage to building, \$750; damage by the removal of stock, \$1,250; total loss, \$2,000. Mr. Preston is insured with companies represented by Chas. Lauer's agency as follows: Building, \$1,000; stock, \$1,000. Mr. Preston will resume business in a few days. It is thought the fire was the work of an incendiary.
