the total receipts from customs for the \$219,986,223. The receipts for internal revenue for the year were \$146,-436,377, and from miscellaneous sources, \$37,430,873, making in all \$403, 855,473. The current expenses of the government was \$187,639,093. The Drugs, collections at the New York Custom House were \$146,578,626, other cities following in the order named: Boston, Philadephia, San Francisco, Baltimore, New Orleans, Chicago, Galveston, St. Louis, and Burlington (Vermont). The cost of the maintainance of the New York Custom House is not far from \$2,500,000 annually annually. The number of employees is about 1200.
