Government Revenue.
The Treasury Department reports the total receipts from customs for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1883, at \$219,986,223. The receipts for internal revenue for the year were \$146,436,377, and from miscellaneous sources, \$37,430,873, making in all \$403,853,473. The current expenses of the government was \$187,639,693. The collections at the New York Custom House were \$146,578,626, other cities following in the order named: Boston, Philadelphia, San Francisco, Baltimore, New Orleans, Chicago, Galveston, St. Louis, and Burlington (Vermont). The cost of the maintenance of the New York Custom House is not far from \$2,500,000 annually. The number of employees is about 1200.

The St. Paul Globe in speaking of the Northern Pacific terminus at St. Paul says: "Three hundred and eighty acres in St. Paul, with one hundred in the business center, and five million dollars to develop it indicates that the Northern Pacific means business at this point. Their 20 acres at Minneapolis will give them abundant yard room at that point, but the real terminal work and buildings will be upon the three hundred and eighty acres in St. Paul."
