The Roseburg Plaindealer says Thursday of last week Joseph Hopkins was found in a helpless condition at his coal mine near Looking Glass. Peter Birch was going out to the mine and found Mr. Hopkins in a ditch, having been stricken with paralysis. He immediately took him to his cabin, which was near at hand, put dry clothes on him and remained there during the night. On Friday Mr. Hopkins seemed much better, and they started to Looking Glass, but the shock was much more severe than at first supposed and he died the day following. Mr. Hopkins came to Oregon eight years ago and had discovered the coal mine near Looking Glass. He was highly respected by all who knew him, and his sudden death cast a gloom over that entire community.


