General Hancock's Opinion.

St. Louis, Jan. 23.—General Hancock, on his return from California and the southwest, says: "I have had a delightful tour among the soldiers of the southwest, and I find the army in splendid condition. Do I think the next president will be a Democrat? I certainly do, unless the party commits greater blunder than can possibly be anticipated. The tariff question is naturally coming up again, and is designed to cut a broad figure in the coming political campaign. I think Carlisle is going to make himself the greatest speaker of the house, and his tariff views will undoubtedly become the Democratic party platform. Yes, there is every reason to believe that we will win the race."

Preparations for the twelfth annual convention of the Oregon State Woman Suffrage Association are going forward rapidly. The meeting will commence on the 12th of February and will continue through two days and evenings, and in view of the pending suffrage amendment it is regarded as the most important meeting ever held by advocates of equal rights in Oregon. A large delegation is expected from various localities in the state and a vigorous campaign will be planned. The Republican journals are complaining because the Democracy of Ohio have elected a rich man to the United States Senate. However they are silent about such rich Republican Senators as Wood Pulp Miller, Fur Seal Miller, Jones, Hale, Sabin, Sawyer, Palmer, Plumb, Bowen, Sherman, Cameron, Hill, Sewall, Mahone and several others.

The people of Lane county should subscribe liberally to the stock of the Lane County Agricultural Association, as it will not only prove a paying investment, but it will do much to encourage our farmers to improve in their present methods of farming and stock raising. Eugene City, alone, should take \$3,000 of the capital stock.

It is said by the knowing ones that Mitchell and his friends are engaged in selecting proper legislative candidates for the coming June election. Who will be the men selected for cru cifixion in Lane.

One by one the bolters of Marion county are being appointed to Federal offices. Rigdon is the last receiving a fat position from Dolph for deserting Mitchell.

There are nearly 2,000 idle men in Portland, and at least 1,000 of them are "broke." Tramps will be plentiful in the valley soon.

They call it now the "Oregon Transcontinental," in Portland.

A destructive fire occurred at Prime ville at about 1 o'clock Saturday morning. The merchandise store of Selling & Hinckley, a vacant building adjoining Kelly's saloon, J. T. Bushnell's harness shop, an unoccupied building in close proximity, S. Wilson's saloon and Gill Glaze's livery stable were soon a mass of black and smoking ruins. Here the flames were stopped in their mad career by an open space. The loss is estimated at \$10,000; insured \$3300. The fire was undoubtedly the work of an incendiary.

During the year 1883, we had accounts of 1494 murders in this country. 80 wives were killed by their husbands, 39 children by parents, 10 husbands by wives. Ohio is credited with 116 murders. In New York there were 54, and 104 in the State. It is still a peg or two to the millennium.

Lane county has more varied resources than any other in Oregon. In tending immigrants should make a note of this fact.
