It is a very easymatter to map out general results for Congress to accomplish, but it is not a ways so easy to define the means by which they are to be reached. The present Democratic House of Representatives has laid out some excellent work, but the execution of it in a great measure is dependent upon the acquiescence of the Republican Senate and a partisan Executive. The issues, however, can be made, and the fault for failing to institute necessary reforms will be put by the people where it belongs. have no intention of going through the calendar of Congressional business to show what the Democrats have undertaken. But there are some questions which have risen into greater prominence than others, and these can be briefly defined as the following propositions:

- 1. To reduce appropriations within reasonable limits.
- 2. To reduce taxation to the absolute needs of the Government.

To restore the rorfeited land grants to the public domain,

4. The exposure of official fraud, and to provide means for the punishment of official rascality.

3. These, it is true, are general propositions, but they are susceptible of a special application, which will give more than ordinary interest to the discussion of public affairs. The last half dozen years have been prolific in corruption, extravagance and and official recklessness. It is time that a limit shall be put to this, and the Democratic House will at least do its duty in the premises .- S. F. Examiner.




