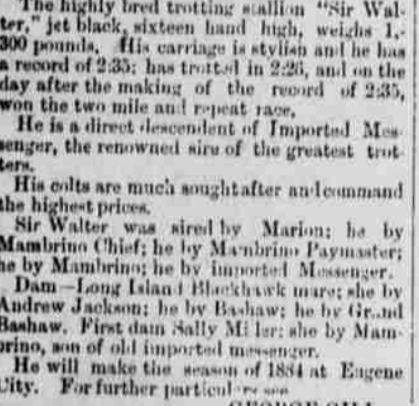


Duties on Clothing.
