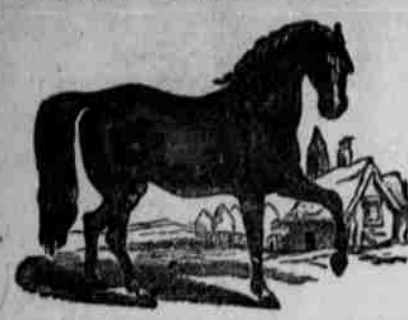


"SIR WALTER."
