

The St. Louis Republican makes a good but not a new point against the management of the Associated Press: That after publishing as news the opinion of Theodore Roosevelt about the Chicago nominations, it refused to publish as news the opinion of Carl Schurz, and ordered its agent at St. Louis to suppress the item.

Hon. W. A. Smith, late Republican member of Congress from North Carolina, and the most prominent Republican in that State, has openly declared himself a Democrat now and henceforth. He says Blaine is too heavy for him to carry, and that he has voted his last Republican ticket. He intends stamping the State for the Democratic nominee.

John C. S. Harrison, a wealthy gentleman of Indianapolis, who has always been prominently identified with the Republican party, has repudiated the Chicago nominations. He was a director of the Union Pacific Railroad in 1876, and says he is in possession of damaging facts concerning Blaine's record in that connection that compels him to oppose Mr. Blaine for President.

Mr. Blaine's chief attraction, to a certain class of people, consists in his supposed aptitude for plunging the country into foreign wars. Some years ago, however, when there was fighting to be done, he hired a substitute.
