Acting upon this discovery, a noted engineer recently employed a centrifugal machine which he constructed hastily, and found that action for one hour, the number of germs was reduced 90 per cent. Upon the basis of this experiment, it would usem possible to clear a city's water supply by subjecting it to a centrifugal motion.
