S. W. Talenage, the Milwaukee aut o ity, has revised his estimate of the wheat crop of the United States. The estimate shows the probable yield of spring wheat 121,000,000 bushels; winter, 210,000,000 bushels; total spring and winter, 331,000,000 bushels. From these figures it will be seen that the crop of 1885, compared with 1884, will show a shortage in winter wheat of 160,000,000 bushels; spring wheat, 22,000,000; total shortage, spring and winter, 182,000,000. The average wheat yield of the United States for five years past is 461,000,000 bushels. The estimate shows a shortage, compaced with the average five years past of 130,000,000 bushels.

Mr. Talmadge estimates the Oregon wheat product at 17,000,000 bushels, and places the Washington territory yield at 5;000,000, while California is credited with 28,000,000 bushels, or 30,000,000 more than any other wheat producing state,

The Commissioner of the General Land office has declined to accede to the request of the Oregon and California Railway company for the issue of 325,900 acres of land already selected by the company, and to allow selections to be made from a million acres more, under the lapsed land grant to that company in the State of Oregon. The grant expired in 1884, and bills declaring forfeiture were before Congress at the last session. The Commissioner says that until the matter of enforcing forfeiture has been determined by Congress or the courts, it is his opinion that he should take no steps which would place it beyond the power of the I legislative branch to protect public rights in the premises. We believe this to be the proper course for the government to pursue, for a railroad -corporation ought to have no greater rights then an individual who fails to comply with his contracts. This company having failed to complete the road within the time agreed, cannot justly be entitled to this land .-- Plaindealer.






