

Temperance Conventions.

From a lengthy article handed us for publication, we extract the following: It is recommended that the third week in this month, from the 20th to the 27th, be observed as the centennial week by all organizations throughout the State connected with the temperance work, and that special meetings be held. It is specially recommended that three district centennial conventions be held, one at Albany, one at Roseburg, and one at La Grande, on the 23d and 24th. All churches, Sunday schools and temperance societies are invited to send one or more delegates.

The colored people have three well organized colleges in Atlanta and are building a fourth. One thousand young negroes attended the three colleges during the last term. Besides there were 2000 negro children in the public schools of the city. A high standard of scholarship has been established at the colleges, says the Atlanta Constitution, and the average proficiency of the students is fine.

The colored voters in the Southern States no longer feel that their political rights depend upon the commercial patriots who have been masquerading as their protectors. In Virginia a call has been issued for a colored Republican convention, for the purpose of putting an anti-Mahone State ticket in the field.
