The fastest trotting horse in the world, so far as has been proven, is Maud S, whose record stands undisputed and unrivalled at 2:08} to the mile. This little "flyer" is owned by Robt. Bonner, who, it is said, has never ridden behind her but once. Her trotting has always been for the benefit of the public, because Mr. Bonner would not permit her to go on the turf to contest for purses. She has made two or three attempts to heat her own fastest time, but has not succeeded in so doing. Mr. Bonner proposes new to give her a rest, and when in harness to draw the reins on her himself. She is an expensive luxury, and as Mr. Bonner purchased her for a high price, he ought to enjoy a "spin" behind her on this occasion; if for no other reason than to remind him that he must improve his time, as it will only be a few years until her trotting days are over.

The growth of opium in China is attributed by a good observer to the increase of Mohammedans in the empire: There are now not less than 20,-000,000 moslems in China, and as these people are forbidden to smoke tobacco or to drink wine or liquor, they fall back for stimulant and narcotic in one opium, which they eat in large quantities. The North China provinces now supply nearly all the opium consumed there, and the prospect is that a few years will see a great falling off in the imports of Indian opium, and that before the close of the century China will virtually produce all her own opium.

When the Senate meets there will be a list of between 500 and 600 postmasters appointed during recess submitted for confirmation. In addition, it is estimated that during the session of Congress the terms of at least 600 postmasters will expire, so that nominations of over 1000 postmasters will cane before the Senate during the next session. There are 2335 presidential postmasters in this country, and at the rate observed during the past six months all the presidential postmasters will be changed in two years,
