The San Francisco Argonaut, Republican, in the course of a long editorial on the Eastern elections, says: "Republicans are by the recent elections in New York compelled to admit that the Empire State is no longer a Republican one. The triumph of Cleveland for governor; the defeat of Blaine for president, and now the election of Hill, seems to place New York prominently in the column of Democratic states."

Lawsuits are sometime rather expensive luxuries. A case has just been concluded in a circuit court in Iowa, which in the beginning might have been settled for \$850; but the fighting disposition of the parties involved prevented a settlement. The matter has been in the courts eleven years, cost over \$20,000 and bankrupted several prosperous farmers.

The proposal of a southern newspapaper to take the erection of a monement to Gen. Grant out of the dillatory hands of the north and to have it completed by the money of the south may be regarded in the lexicon of Evarts, Blaine, Sherman, Logan and Foraker as "another southern outrage."

There will be no more elections in the United States in October. The last one to adhere to the October system was Ohio, and at the late election in that State it was determined by an affirmative vote of 537,000 that all elections shall hereafter be held in November.

The postoffice at Plymouth, Utah, was discontinued a few day ago for the reason that every one had moved out of the town, leaving the postmaster with his four wives and tifteen children as the only occupants of the place.

At a wedding in Walla Walla last Saturday, when the minister asked the prospective husband if he would take that woman to be his wedded wife, the agitated reply was; " Yes, siree-yes, sir, if you please."

An Iowa agriculture paper recently received contains a slanderous para graph on the Oregon hog, alleging that the typical poker of this State is the scrubbiest kind of a Missouri scrub.

The general appropriation bill passed by the last legislature foots up \$28,633, \$16,000 of which is devoted to the payment of the expenses of the special session of the legislature.

The Philadelphia Press, Republican, says: "The fact is, men and brethern, this country is getting a little too much war history from fellows who didn't do any of the fighting."


