

Senator Beck's Children.
"Carp," in his Washington letter, in the Cleveland Leader, says that "George Beck, the only son of the Senator, is a bright boy yet under 30, who has made a fortune in Wyoming Territory. He has a ranch of over 1000 acres, and I am told that his profits this year will amount to about \$40,000. On his ranch he has twelve miles of ditching, and the main ditch is six feet wide and four feet deep. He has 200 acres in wheat, and his mill grinds the flour for the neighborhood. Senator Beck goes West nearly every Summer to visit his son. He is very proud of him, and is probably satisfied to have him out of politics. One of Mr. Beck's daughters married a Mr. Corcoran, a relative of the philanthropist. She was quite a belle here years ago, but is dead now. His other daughter is the wife of Major Goodloe, of Kentucky."

According to the information of the National Department of Agriculture the area of corn in the United States in 1885 was 73,000,000 acres; of wheat 34,000,000, of oats 23,000,000. The value of corn averages nearly 33 cents per bushel and makes an aggregate of \$635,000,000, \$5,000,000 less than the value of the last crop. The decrease in the product of wheat is 30 per cent. and only 17 per cent. in valuation, which is \$275,000,000. The valuation of oats is \$180,000,000. The reduction of wheat is mostly in the valley of the Ohio and in California. The states of Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Missouri and Kansas, last year, produced 170,000,000, this year 80,000,000. The production of all cereals is 63 bushels to each inhabitant and the aggregate volume is greater than any former year.

The Postoffice Department in its instructions regarding delivery, says: "Neither husband nor wife can control the delivery of correspondence addressed to the other. When so instructed the Postmaster must refuse to deliver letters to the husband, which are addressed to the wife, and vice versa; in the absence of instructions to the contrary, the wife's letters should be placed in the husband's box or delivered to him with his own letters."

Mrs. Grant's profits on the subscriptions for her husband's book already taken will be \$508,000. The book was circulated in England and Germany. France and Italy will have the book next. The second volume, which is larger than the first, will be ready in March.
